

## **BIBLE PASSAGES AND QUESTIONS**

The story of the first Passover is found in Exodus. You may remember that God called Moses to lead His people, the Israelites, out of slavery in Egypt.

Read Exodus 4:1-15

What did Moses say to God about what God asked him to do? What did God promise Moses?

Read Exodus 7:10-13

What happened when Moses went to Pharaoh to ask for the people to go free?

Read Exodus 7:14-17, 8:1-3, 8:16, 8:21

What did God do when Pharaoh said "NO?"

Read Exodus 11:1-7, 12:3, 6-13

What was the last plague? What instructions did Moses give the people?

Read 12:29

What happened in Egypt that night?

Read Exodus 12:31

What did Pharaoh do?

What does the story of Moses and the Israelites teach us about trusting God?

Read Exodus 12:14, 17

Why do the Jewish people prepare a special dinner every year for Passover?  
(to remember that God saved them from slavery in Egypt)

Read John 1:29

How does the Passover Feast, a Jewish celebration, relate to us as Christians?  
(To save themselves, the Israelites killed a lamb as a sacrifice. For us, Jesus was the ultimate sacrifice to save us from our sin.)

Read Matthew 26:17-19 and 26-30

What happened when Jesus celebrated Passover with his disciples for the last time?  
(He broke the bread, they shared the cup, and he told them to do this in remembrance of him. He was telling them that he was sacrificing himself for them. They celebrated this Last Supper. In remembrance of this meal, we celebrate Communion.)
